

Our team offers outpatient therapy to people with a neurological condition. We will work to help you reach your goals to regain as much independence as possible.


We offer in-person, virtual and telephone visits.

- Able to arrange own transportation to our clinic

- Improve your ability to speak, read and write
- · Cope with your emotions and mood
- Link with community services and supports



Your healthcare team:

Your healthcare team may include one or more of the following members:

- Physiotherapist
- Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy Assistant

What you can expect:

- Your first appointment will last about 1 hour, per therapist.
- How often you attend therapy appointments and how long you are in the program will be determined by you and your therapists.
